

CONTEST RULES
"GET THE HELL OUT OF HERE-Big White Ski Resort"

1. (a) To enter starting 6:01 am MT, on March 13, 2010, visit www.sonic102.com, join the Glee Loyalty club and redeem 1,000 points for an entry into the Contest before 11:59 pm MT, on March 18, 2010, the Contest Closing Date.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. To enter this Contest without redeeming 1,000 Points, during the Contest Period, please hand print your name, address, day and evening phone numbers, email address, age, Contest name for which you are entering for a chance to win, and a hand written 100 word letter explaining why you want to win a trip away and mail it to, 5915 Gateway Blvd, Edmonton AB, T6H 2H3.
